  - (ii) kept separate Income Statement for each subvented service unit as required by the Lump Sum Grant Manual (LSG Manual) published by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR);
  - (iii) prepared the Annual Financial Report in accordance with the format and requirements set out in the LSG Manual; and
  - (iv) employed the staff quoted in the Provident Fund arrangements during the year ended 31 March, 2021.

#### 1. Lump Sum Grant (LSG)

a. Basis of preparation

The Annual Financial Report (AFR) is prepared in respect of all Funding and Service Agreement (FSA) activities (including support services to FSA activities) funded by the Social Welfare Department under the Lump Sum Grant Subvention System. AFR is prepared <u>on cash basis</u>, that is, income is recognised upon receipt of cash and expenditure is recognised when expenses are paid. <u>Non-cash items</u> such as depreciation, provisions and accruals <u>have not been included</u> in the AFR.

This represents LSG (excluding Provident Fund) received for the year.

c. Provident Fund This is Provident Fund received and contributed during the year.
